

High School - Drug Test Policy

ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES 7 – 12 PARTICIPATING IN ANY SCHOOL SPONSORED EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY OR WHO APPLIES FOR A DISTRICT PARKING PERMIT CAN BE INITIALLY TESTED

ALL NAMES ARE PLACED IN A POOL AND TEN TIMES A YEAR AND THE DRUG-TESTING LAB WILL RANDOMLY SELECT 40-50 STUDENTS FROM THE POOL TO BE TESTED

IF A SAMPLE TESTS POSITIVE:

FIRST OFFENSE:

1. Notify parents and a conference is held
2. Student is given the following options:
 - a. Agree to participate in an assistance and drug education program. Agree to a 30-day school suspension from sponsored extracurricular activities. Agree to further urinalysis.
 - b. Be suspended from school sponsored extracurricular activities for the remainder of the school year and submit to drug testing prior to the start of the next season.

SECOND OFFENSE:

1. Notify parents and conference is held
2. Student is suspended from school sponsored activities for one calendar year from the date of the offense

THIRD OFFENSE:

1. Notify parents and a conference is held
2. Student is not allowed to participate in extracurricular activities for the remainder of the student's high school career

IF AN IN-SEASON SUSPENSION WOULD LAST LONGER THAN THE SCHEDULED PLAYING DATES, THE PERCENTAGE OF GAMES REMAINING ON THE SUSPENSION SHALL BE HELD OVER AND ENFORCED DURING THE NEXT SEASON IN WHICH THE STUDENT PARTICIPATES

IF A STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE DURING THE OFF-SEASON, THE STUDENT SHALL MISS THE FIRST 30 PERCENT OF GAMES FOR THE NEXT SPORT HE OR SHE PARTICIPATES

A REFUSAL TO TEST SHALL BE DEEMED AS A POSITIVE TEST
