

## SHHS 2018 Fall Exemption Guidelines

**9th and 10th grade students will not be eligible for exemption of fall semester exams.**

**11 graders:** 1-3 absences = 4 exemptions.

Must have an 80 or above in each class for which an exemption is taken.

**12th graders:** 1-3 absences= MAY EXEMPT ALL CLASSES in which the student has an 80 or higher for the semester.

\*\*Greater than 3 absences in ANY period results in a loss of all exemptions.

\*\* 3 Tardies= 1 absence

\*\*A disciplinary placement of on campus or off campus suspension results in a loss of ALL exemptions.

\*\* Students who have enrolled after the completion of the second six weeks will be required to take exams.

### **11th Grade additional incentive:**

Perfect Attendance-is defined as zero absences in all classes. If a student has perfect attendance, they are eligible to exempt all classes in which they have an 80 or higher semester average. School related absences do not count against the student.

\*\*Also, a student will be excused from a temporary absence resulting from appointments with healthcare professionals, if the student commences classes or returns to school on the same day of the appointment with a doctor's note. All health care professional notes must be returned within three (3) days after the appointment or will be marked as an absence and will count against the exemption absences.
