Community: Spring Hill Independent School District, established in 1881, serves a student body of approximately 1964 students. Located in the northwest area of Longview, TX, Spring Hill ISD includes four campuses – primary (K-2), intermediate (3–5), junior high (6–8), and high school (9-12). Spring Hill is classified as 4A in University Interscholastic League competition.

School: Spring Hill High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school with a current enrollment of 537 students in grades 9 – 12. Current ethnic distribution is 69.98% White, 9.58% African American, 14.55% Hispanic, 1.47% Asian, .92% American Indian/Alaskan, .18% Hawaiian/Pacific Islander and 3.31% with two or more. 32.78% of high school students are economically disadvantaged.

Curriculum: The academic program is an organized schedule of eight 47-minute class periods. Seniors must attend a minimum of six classes on campus each day.

AP® courses are offered in English Language, English Literature, Calculus AB, Biology, Chemistry, World History, US History, United States Government, Macroeconomics, Seminar, Research, Studio Art Drawing and Studio Art 2D Design.

Advanced classes are offered in Honors English 1, Honors English 2, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Physics, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Honors World Geography, and Spanish 3.

Juniors and seniors are permitted to enroll in a number of freshmen level college courses at local institutions of higher learning and earn dual and/or early admission college credits.

Class of 2019

There were 111 graduates in the Class of 2019 and of those 82% were College/Career/Military Ready.

Standardized Test Results

- ❖ 54% of the Class of 2019 (60) took the ACT, with an average composite score of 22.
- ❖ 23% of the Class of 2019 (26) took the SAT, with the following averages: Evidenced Based Reading/Writing: 574; Math: 567

Post-High School Placement

- ❖ 38% planned to attend a 4-year college or university
- ❖ 49% planned to attend a 2-year institution
- ❖ 2% planned to attend a technical school
- ❖ 6% planned to join the military
- ❖ 5% planned to join the workforce

2019 Advanced Placement Results

- ❖ In May 2019, 89 students (sophomores, juniors and seniors) took AP Exams.
- ❖ A total of 171 exams were taken in 10 subjects
- ❖ 52.0% of the AP Exams received scores of 3 or higher
- ❖ 17 Scholars: AP Scholar: 9; AP Scholar with Honor: 2; AP Scholar with Distinction: 6

2019 Dual Credit Results

- ❖ 41 students received credit in dual credit courses.
- ❖ 180 dual credit courses were completed.
- ❖ 540 college credits were accrued.
